

Imperative Morpheme Chart

	Active (& Aor. Pass.)	Middle-Passive
2s	--, ζ, θι (or ??)	σο (or ??)
3s	τω	σθω
2p	τε	σθε
3p	τωσαν	σθωσαν

Note: The endings on the forms λῦσον (Ao A Impv 2s) and λῦσαι (Ao M Impv 2s) are unaccounted for.

Note: the Aorist Passive in all moods uses the *active personal endings*, as well, in the non-finite forms (ptc and inf), it uses the *active morphemes* (ντ for act. ptc morph., ναι for act. inf. morph.).

Note: The form λύθητι (Ao P Impv 2s) originally had θι for its ending, but theta was deaspirated to tau due to the preceding aspirate--theta: λύθηθι --> λύθητι. The -θι is retained in the impv 2s of εἰμί: ἴσθι (Be!).

Note: The active 2s ending -ζ is not common, but it can be seen in the -μι verb conjugation: δός Give! (AoAImpv 2s of δίδωμι); θές Put! (AoAImpv 2s of τίθημι).
