Note: The endings on the forms $\lambda\tilde{\upsilon}\sigma\sigma\nu$ (Ao A Impv 2s) and $\lambda\tilde{\upsilon}\sigma\alpha\iota$ (Ao M Impv 2s) are unaccounted for.

Note: the Aorist Passive in all moods uses the *active personal endings*; as well, in the non-finite forms (ptc and inf), it uses the *active morphemes* ($v\tau$ for act. ptc morph., $v\alpha\iota$ for act. inf. morph.).

Note: The form $\lambda \hat{\upsilon} \theta \eta \tau \iota$ (Ao P Impv 2s) originally had $\theta \iota$ for its ending, but theta was deaspirated to tau due to the preceding aspirate--theta: $\lambda \hat{\upsilon} \theta \eta \theta \iota \longrightarrow \lambda \hat{\upsilon} \theta \eta \tau \iota$. The $-\theta \iota$ is retained in the impv 2s of $\epsilon \hat{\iota} \mu \hat{\iota}$: $\tilde{\iota} \sigma \theta \iota$ (Be!).

Note: The active 2s ending - ζ is not common, but it can be seen in the - μ 1 verb conjugation: $\delta \delta \zeta$ Give! (AoAImpv 2s of $\delta \delta \omega \mu$ 1); $\theta \delta \zeta$ Put! (AoAImpv 2s of $\tau \delta \eta \mu$ 1).
