- סוסָתָן “their mare” (5)
- סוסָתְכֶן “your mare” (6)
- מְקוֹמִי “my place” (7)
- מְקוֹמוֹ “his place” (8)
- בְּרַכְתָּהּ “her blessing” (9)
- בְּרַכְתְּכֶם “your blessing” (10)

B. For each of the following words, provide the lexical form (the basic, or dictionary form) and identify the pronominal suffix by person, #, and gender; then provide a translation.

- (1) שֻׁלְחָן + 2ms, “your table”
- (2) זִקְנָן + 3fs, “her elders”
- (3) חִכְמָה + 1cs, “my wisdom”
- (4) אֹרֶן + 3ms, “his light”
- (5) סוּס + 3mp, “their horses”
- (6) מִצְוָה + 2fs, “your commandment”
- (7) דְּבָרָן + 3mp, “their word”
- (8) יְשׁוּעָה + 3fp, “their salvation”
- (9) דְּבָרֶיךָ + 2fp, “your words”
- (10) תּוֹרָה + 1cp, “our law”
