If it is in the construct, write down “cst” in the appropriate place. If it is a ptc form, you do not need to mark “person” since participles are only marked for number and gender, not person. If the participle is active instead of passive, you do not need to mark it as active, since we assume the participle is active unless you specify it as passive. [I have filled in a few of the boxes for you already.]
