## Hebrew Grammar Lesson 30 Drills on Hiphil Forms ANSWER KEY

Parse the following forms and translate into English. For parsing, give Verbal Root, Stem, and where applicable Conjugation/Tense, Person, Gender, Number. If two answers are possible, provide both. [Consult the vocab list from Ch. 30!]

Ex: שׁמֵר = שְׁמֶרַׁתְנִי Qal pft 3fs + 1cs sfx "she guarded/kept me"

- 1. קרב אַקריב Hiph impf 1cs "I will bring near, present, draw near"
- 2. קריבֶה Hiph coh 1cs "let me bring near, present, draw near"
- 3. קרב הַקְרַבְּתֶּם Hiph pft 2mp "you brought near, presented, drew near"
- 4. זכר יַזְכִּיר Hiph impf 3ms "he will remind, keep in remembrance, commemorate"
- 5. זכר הַזְּכֵּיר Hiph infc "to remind, keep in remembrance, commemorate"
- 6. זכר הַזְּכִּיר Hiph pft 3ms "he reminded, kept in remembrance, commemorated"
- 7. הַּזְבֵּר Hiph impv 2ms "remind, keep in remembrance, commemorate!"; OR Hiph infa "to remind, keep in remembrance, commemorate"
- 8. זכר יַזְבֵּר Hiph juss 3ms "let him / may he remind, keep in remembrance, commemorate"
- 9. לבשׁ הַּלְבַּרשׁר Hiph impv 2mp "clothe/array (someone)!"
- 10. לבשׁ הֹלְבׁרשׁר Hiph pft 3cp "they clothed/arrayed (someone)"
- 11. בישׁרם Hiph ptc mp + article המֹלְבִּרשׁים "the ones clothing/arraying (someone)" or "the ones who clothes/arrays (someone)"
- 12. לבשׁ תַּלְבֵּשְׁבָה Hiph impf 3fp/2fp "they (women) / you (women) will clothe/array (someone)"

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup>Note: the  $\pi$  here is not a stem prefix from the Hiphil stem. The  $\alpha$  is standing where the stem prefix  $\pi$  would be; the presence of  $\alpha$  plus the ending ים indicates that we're dealing here a participle. The  $\pi$  plus dagesh forte is the marker of the definite article, "the."
