

Line Diagramming Practice Sheet #3: John 3 ANSWER KEY


For the following verses (or portions thereof) in John 3, [1] Identify the clause pattern/type by labeling the constituent structure for each main clause and for each dependent clause--if there is one. [2] Then draw a line diagram based on the handouts you have received in class (and Grassmick).

1. v. 2a οὗτος ἦλθεν πρὸς αὐτὸν νυκτὸς

English Gloss/Translation: “He came to him by night.”

Clause Pattern: S V




2. v. 6 τὸ γεγεννημένον ἐκ τῆς σαρκὸς σάρξ ἔστιν, καὶ τὸ γεγεννημένον ἐκ τοῦ πνεύματος πνεῦμά ἔστιν.

English Gloss/Translation: “What is born of the flesh is flesh, and what is born of the spirit is spirit.”

Clause Pattern: S V SC; S V SC [compound-complex sentence; each indep. clause has an “embedded” clause within it in the form of a participial phrase functioning as S]

3. v. 8 τὸ πνεῦμα ὅπου θέλει πνεῖ καὶ τὴν φωνὴν αὐτοῦ ἀκούεις

English Gloss/Translation: “The wind blows where it wills, and you hear its sound.”

Clause Pattern: Main clause 1 = S V; Embedded clause = (S) V; Main clause 2 = S V DO
