

Line Diagramming Practice Sheet #4: John 3:16 ANSWERS

For John 3:16, [1] Identify the clause pattern/type by labeling the constituent structure for each main clause and for each dependent clause. [2] Then draw a line diagram based on the handouts you have received in class (and Grassmick).

οὗτος γὰρ ἡγάπησεν ὁ θεὸς τὸν κόσμον, ὅστε τὸν οὐίον τὸν μονογενῆ ἔδωκεν, ἵνα πᾶς ὁ πιστεύων εἰς αὐτὸν μὴ ἀπόληται ἀλλ' ἔχῃ ζωὴν αἰώνιον.

English Gloss/Translation: “For God loved the world in this way, that he gave his only-begotten Son, so that everyone believing in him will not perish, but have eternal life.”

Clause Pattern: Main Clause--S V DO; Dep. Clause #1--(S) V DO; Dep. Clause #2--S V // V DO [the compound predicate has two different predicate structures but the same S]
