IBH 9.7

a. 1–6 (I provide all 15 in case you want to practice with 7–15.)

(1) מֵהֶעֱבֵד/מִן־הֶעֱבֵד¹ הַנְּבִיא צָדִיק

(2) הָאִישׁ הַטּוֹב בְּעִיר הַרְשָׁעָה (הַרְעָה)

(3) וְהַמְּלָךְ רְשָׁע² הַגְּבוּרִים יִשְׂרָאֵל

(4) הָאָרֶץ הַגְּדוֹלָה יִפְּהָ

(5) יְהֹוָה גָּדוֹל מִהְנִבְיאָה/ מִן־הַנִּבְיאָה

(6) הַנְּשִׁים הַיְפּוֹת פָּה

(7) הַעֲבֹדָה קָשָׁה מִהִלְדִּים/ מִן־הִלְדִּים

(8) סְפָרִים טֹבִים רַבִּים בְּהַיְכָל

(9) חַכְמָה יִקְרָה מִזְהָב/ מִן־זָהָב

(10) בְּדֶרֶךְ אֶל־הַמְּלָחָמָה³ הַגְּבוּרִים הַיִשְׂרָאֵל/ הַיִשְׂרָאֵים

(11) הַנְּשִׁים הַיְפּוֹת בְּגַן

(12) יִשְׁבֵּן מֶלֶךְ רֹעֵן וְרָשָׁע בְּהַיְכָל

¹ Another acceptable word order is to put the predicate adj first: צָדִיק הַנִּבְיאָה... Note: for this exercise, I'm providing both ways to attach the prep so that you can get accustomed to seeing it both ways; however, since the way that uses assimilation is more difficult, going forward I will usually provide only that way when creating a word with the מִן attached.

² Another acceptable word order is to put the predicate adj first: יִשְׂרָאֵל הַמְּלָךְ רְשָׁע. This is true for many other sentences in section a: ##4, 5, 7, 9, 13, 14. I provide one more ex. for #13 below.

³ Recall that when a SQNMLVY letter (and yod is one of them) has a DF inside and a VS underneath, it often loses the DF and the VS becomes SS. The two forms given here represent both possibilities. Compare also with #7 above.

(14) **בֶּן רָשָׁע קָשָׁה מִבֶּן צָדִיק/מִזֶּבֶן צָדִיק**

(15) **הַלְּכָו הַעֲבָדִים הַרְשָׁעִים בְּפֶרַם**

b. 1-7

- (3) Who is wicked? The lad is very wicked.
- (4) The precious books are in the temple.
- (5) The upright prophets are in the great house.
- (6) The evil man dwelt in the beautiful (or excellent) city.
- (7) The wicked warriors went (walked) to the great temple.
