B. For each of the following words, provide the lexical form (the basic, or dictionary form) and identify the pronominal suffix by person, #, and gender; then provide a translation.

שְׁלֻחָן + 2ms, “your table” (1)

מִצְוָה + 2fs, “your commandment” (6)

זָקֵן + 3fs, “her elders” (2)

דְּבַר + 3mp, “their word” (7)

חִכְמָה + 1cs, “my wisdom” (3)

יְשׁוּעָה + 3fp, “their salvation” (8)

אוֹר + 3ms, “his light” (4)

דְּבַר + 2fp, “your words” (9)

סוּס + 3mp, “their horses” (5)

תּוֹרָה + 1cp, “our law” (10)
