Translate the following phrases/clauses. Parse the verbal form

(1) אָנִי כָתַב / כָּתַבְתָּ

(7) הִיא מְצֵאת

(2) הֵלְכוּ לְפָנַי יְהוָה

(8) בָּחַר בִּי²

(3) גַּפְלָה¹ עַל פְּנֵיהָ

(9) אִשׁ נִפְלְתָ/נִפְלָ³ מִהַשָּׁמַיִם

(4) אַתָּה לֹא שִׁפְט

(10) הֵם / הֵמָּה אֹמְרִים

(5) הַנָּשִׁים קִבְּצוּת

(11) אֲנַחְנוּ זֹכְרִים אֶתָּה

(6) לֹא הִרְגֵתָ

(12) הֵם / הֵמָּה עֹבְדִים אֶת

¹Remember, since the word פְּנִים is grammatically plural (although in sense it's singular), it will take the pronominal suffixes that are normally added to *plural nouns*.

²Don't forget that the verb "to choose" בָּחַר takes its direct object with the preposition ב (plus pronominal suffixes, if the object is a pronoun). See vocab p. 123.

³The word "fire" can be either masc. or fem., so either gender on the ptc is ok. See vocab p. 95.
